Atwood Surge Brake Actuators are no longer available these obsolete items can be converted to UFP by DEXTER




2in Ball 8,000 lbs. Three Bolt Mount #83000 (weld on only)

The primary difference between Atwood and Others are the mounting holes
From the top of the trailer tongue to the center of the mounting holes
Atwood mounting holes are located 1" down
Common mounting holes are located 34" down

Do not drill the original holes larger to try and match the offset!

The UFP style is a longer unit and comes with a 3-bolt mount <u>According to UFP:</u> You should drill additional third set of holes in trailer tongue when replacing original two-hole mount Actuators

Atwood utilizes a lock-out lever to create free backing UFP utilizes a lock-out cap, sold separately


